THE MALAYSIAN SUSTAINABLE PALM OIL (MSPO) CERTIFICATION SCHEME is the National Scheme in Malaysia is for Oil Palm Plantations, independent and organised small holdings, and oil palm processing facilities to be certified against the requirements of the MSPO Standards. The Standard described the sustainability requirements for the production throughout the supply chain e.g. from the raw materials to end consumer and makes it possible for each group of produces to demonstrate Sustainable Palm Oil Production.

The Malaysian has announced that the MSPO Certification will become mandatory in faces up to the end of 2019. The mandatory timeline comprise of three stages: plantations companies that already have RSPO/ISCC by 31 Dec 2018; Plantation Companies without RSPO/ISCC Certification by 30 June 2019; and smallholders by 31 Dec 2019.

HOW YOU BENEFIT?

MSPO Certification provides means for credible verification of responsible and sustainable oil palm management practice, which emphasis on the positive social, environmental and economic impacts, while minimising the negative impacts.
