INTRODUCTION

The integration of cattle in oil palm is a form of mixed farming where the combinations of the two commodities can be synergized to optimally utilize same piece of land to maximize land use. The two commodities when properly managed can contribute sustainable food supply especially red meat for nation. In addition, cattle integration can be reduced labour requirement and cost saving in plantation based on size of land of oil palm plantation in Malaysia. 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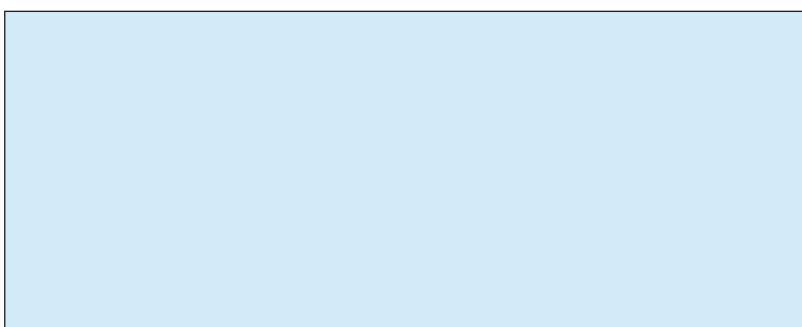
