INTRODUCTION

Malaysia is a developing country and ranked the world's 22nd most competitive economy. As a country involved in a lot of industrial activities such as manufacturing, construction, agriculture, mining, and quarrying, hazardous waste is unavoidable. In Malaysia, hazardous waste is defined as scheduled waste. Scheduled waste are any unwanted matters whether in solid, semi-solid, liquid, or gases which if emitted, released, deposited or discharged to the environment, can be a potential hazard to human and the environment. This is referred to the waste materials that are specified in the "First Schedule of Regulation 2, Environmental Quality (Scheduled Waste) Regulations 2005. (Noor Artika et al. 2004). Thus, the management of scheduled waste is a growing concern in Malaysia due to increase in the number of non-compliances and illegal dumping cases. Managing scheduled wastes requires a comprehensive understanding of regulatory framework, waste properties, waste management concepts, and accepted good management practices
