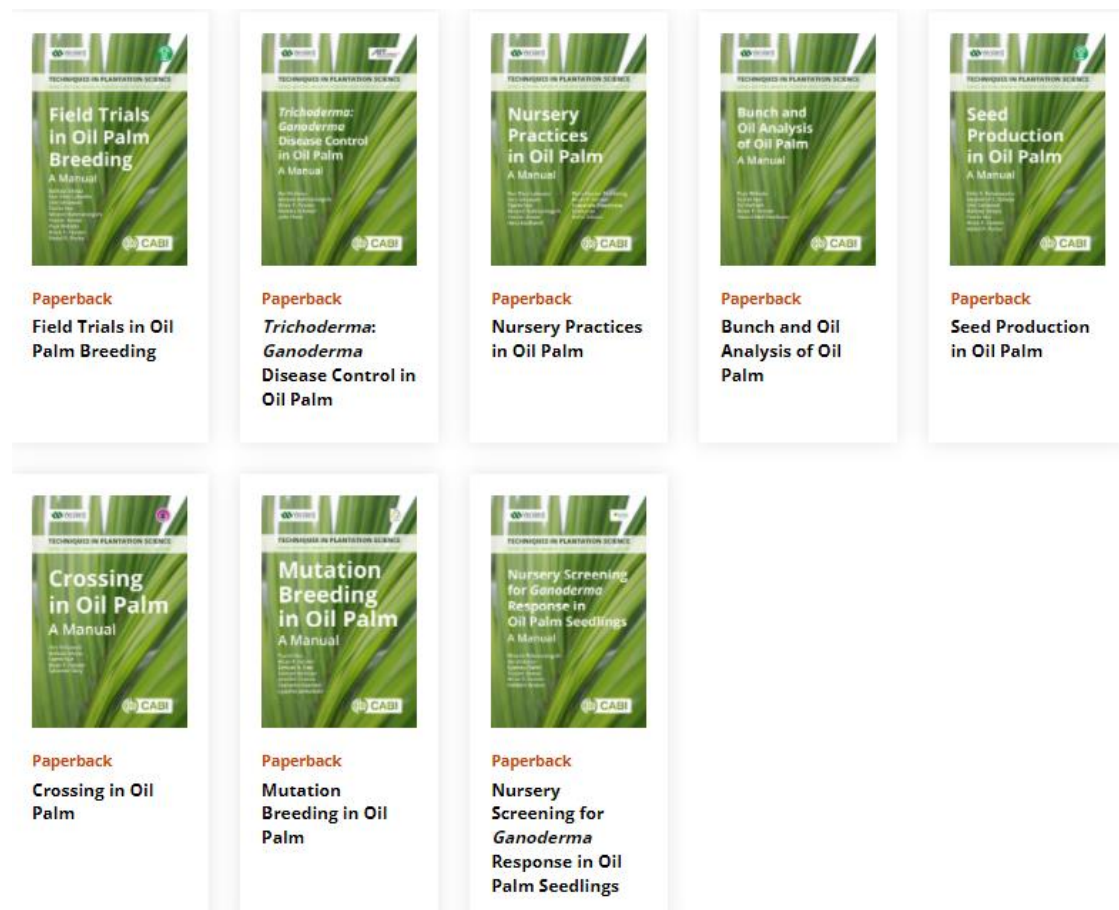


TECHNIQUES IN PLANTATION SCIENCE SERIES

The production of oil palm is widely viewed as destructive to the natural environment, as deforestation endangers native species, especially as demand rises for use in food products, cosmetics and biofuel. However, research has shown that increased production of alternative oils such as soybean, sunflower and rapeseed, would be even more damaging, since they require even more land to produce the same volume of oil.

Promoting agricultural management practices for both large and small-scale producers will contribute to sustainable production of oil palm, with higher yields which reduce the pressure on land use. Providing advice and training is key, and this book series provides valuable information to enable students, researchers and oil palm practitioners to implement best practice and improve the efficiency and sustainability of oil palm, in order to minimise the impact on the environment.
