Chief Executive's Notes

2023 : WIRED FOR MORE SUCCESS

We are truly grateful for a productive year in 2022 despite the challenges and we look forward to 2023 with more optimism. Our plans and programs for the year are all set, and we aim to excel in all facets.

To begin with, membership is of great concern to us since we are a membership-driven organization. We would like to thank all who have renewed their membership. As at 31st December 2022, only 53 per cent have paid their membership subscription. Membership fee is the major income to sustain ISP. One of the efforts taken is that the struck-off members (members who have failed to pay the annual subscription fees for three consecutive years) are now only required to pay the current years' fees unlike in previous years to pay the entire outstanding balance to activate their membership. This initiative is being taken to alleviate the burden of the struck-off members in order to remain in the organisation. As for 2023, members are reminded to settle their dues by 31st March 2023.

It gives me great pleasure to announce that our publication unit has achieved a significant milestone in the timely production of The Planter. The Planter publication has been expedited to be produced on schedule and we hope to keep up with this breakthrough. We invite submission of research articles and write-ups for editorial, sustainability matters, and planters' write sections for *The Planter* issues. We encourage you to opt for the digital version, 'e-planter' which is environmental friendly.

In year 2022, ISPM has actively organised online and physical training in order to enhance planters' knowledge ranging from soft skills to technical know-how. Approximately 400 industry players have attended and benefitted from the trainings conducted in 2022. Besides that, we also welcome you to inform us your preferred area / topic of interests for short courses and trainings. We are looking for new talents and facilitators to offer highly demanding courses in the plantation industry. The LISP/AISP examinations will take place in March 2023. The tutorials will be ongoing to prepare members for the self-study program. The exam serves as a means for planters to acquire their professional knowledge and credentials.

On the ISP branch activities, we would like to thank many branch chairmen and their team who have organised activities and programmes for their members. At the same time, we observed that some branches are less active and this could discourage the members from renewing their subscriptions. We hope the branch could plan and organise activities and events that will be of interest to the members. We encourage members to take up leadership roles in their branches. Branch AGM will be a good platform to elect dedicated and committed members.

We are also working on a corporate video to promote our organisation better. The ISP history and journey are expected to entice new members. The 10th International Planters Conference with the theme of 'Ensuring the Resilience of the Palm Oil Industry in the 21st Century' is to be held on 12th – 14th June 2023. Registration is open with an early birds' rate till 31st March 2023, so take the opportunity to sign up for the conference!! The Planters' Benevolent Trust of Malaysia Fund (Registered Trustees) was established in 1971, under Trustees (Incorporation) Ordinance, 1952 with this Objective :-

Relieving necessitous* persons who are or have been employed in an executive or managerial capacity in an enterprise within the Malaysian plantation industry and the wives, widows and children of such persons.

The Trust exists **to help planters and their dependants in times of need.** The Trust provides grants and allowances to planters or their family member in dire need of financial assistance.

The application will be approved after careful scrutiny of the circumstances of the applicant: the Trustees must satisfy themselves that all potential recipients of the grants and allowances are in genuine difficulties, whether of temporary or long-term nature.

The Trust is administered under a Trust Deed by an independent Board of Trustees, consisting of representatives from the plantation industry appointed by the Malaysian Plam Oil Association (MPOA) and The Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP) under the Chairmanship of an independent party.

This fund is open to all Planters including ISP members and non-ISP members
