• Digitalising The Planter

The work to digitalise *The Planter* magazine had begun a long time ago. It begun with archiving the digital copy of each magazine since the first issue.

When Covid-19 happened, ISP was faced with printing and distribution problems of the magazines. Thus to resolve these, The ISP Board of Directors had decided to distribute to members the digital version of the magazine.

In August 2021, *The Planter* (May 2021 issue) was emailed to members. This continued for all the next issues until the printing and postage services returned to normal. To date the hard copies of the magazine are still being printed but some members have opted to receive the *e-Planter* only permanantly.

• DOI for articles in *The Planter*

Now that we have articles in *The Planter* online, we want these articles to reach the global audience. Therefore ISP had successfully registered with CrossRef to ensure articles in *The Planter* are published with DOI (Digital Object Identifier).

DOI is an identification code for a journal article or other published works. DOIs are used as electronic links to an article's location and helps identify an article's subject matter.

For example, the DOI https://doi.org/10.56333/tp.2022.001 will take you to the article titled "Recent Methods and Technologies for An Early Detection of Red Palm Weevil Infestion: A Review" by Muhammad Nurfaiz Abd Kharim & Kumara Thevan Krishnan, published in the January 2022 issue of *The Planter*.

Academic and professional research travels further if it's linked to the millions of other published papers. This will ensure that articles in *The Planter* are searchable and citable by global researchers and readers.

ISP will continue to maintain the values of articles published in *The Planter*. We hope this good news will encourage members to submit articles to *The Planter*.
