Chief Executive's Notes

REFLECTION ON 2023

As we are about to complete the year 2023, our sincere gratitude to The Incorporated Society of Planters / ISP Management (M) Sdn. Bhd. (ISPM) Board of Directors (BOD), Standing Committees, Task Force, Secretariat, and members for your support and guidance throughout the year. We are looking forward to the National Seminar 2024 (NATSEM 2024) which is to be held on 15-16 July 2024 at Miri, Sarawak, Malaysia. The preparation has been initiated through the publication of the Pre-Announcement. The early bird rate to register for the Seminar is until 31st of March 2024. We have a total of 45 exhibition booths and sponsorships for platinum, gold, and silver. The First Announcement will be sent by 22 December 2023 once speakers and session chairpersons have been confirmed.

Exciting news unfolds as ISP BOD has approved to establish an African Chapter in Nigeria. Mr M.R.Chandran and Mr Mohd Sabre Salim had a courtesy call with the High Commissioner of Nigeria to set up an African Chapter and provide training to the estate managers/staffs in Nigeria. Her Excellency Dr Hajara Salim Ibrahim from the High Commission of the Federal Republic of Nigeria is supportive of establishing the Chapter in Nigeria.

In 2023, we noticed most of the Branches are back to pre-pandemic days by organising many activities and programmes for members. Congratulations to the Branch Chairmen and Committee members for maintaining the vibrancy and dynamism of the branches.

Our sincere gratitude to everyone who has renewed their membership so far. As of 15th December 2023, the percentage of members who have paid their subscription is 57. The collection is still not satisfactory. The Secretariat and Branch Chairmen have taken various initiatives to enhance the collection. Hope members will pay the dues by 31 December 2023. New members, totalling 360 have joined ISP. I would like to thank the Branch Chairmen for registering new members. The Board of Directors has approved for the struck-off members to rejoin ISP by paying only their current year fees and entrance fees (need not pay the entire outstanding balance). This decision has enticed 93 members to rejoin ISP.

The online and physical trainings have been going on well. As of 15 December 2023, we have conducted 18 public physical training, 1 public online training and 13 in-house training sessions. Recently, we had signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Methodist Pillay Institute, Sarawak to run Certificate in Plantation Management tentatively from January to May 2024 at Miri, Sibu and Kuching. We are planning to do a couple of in-house courses for many plantation companies and organizations such as FGV Holdings Bhd, Koperasi Ladang Berhad and Cooperative Institute of Malaysia (CIM). We also invite ISP Branches to do joint training programmes with the Secretariat.

We encourage the submission of research articles and write-ups for the editorial. In addition, there are special sections on sustainability matters and planter's write for *The Planter* magazine. An honorarium of between RM 1500 - RM 2500 is paid to the main author of an accepted scientific technical paper for publication in *The Planter*. For an accepted editorial, an honorarium of RM 1500 is paid. Furthermore, the Datuk Leslie Davidson Award is an annual award that carries a monetary reward of RM 2,500 and RM 1500 for the best technical scientific article and the best technical popular article respectively. We appreciate and welcome more articles for *The Planter* magazine. The timely production of *The Planter* is possible upon receiving the articles promptly. Therefore, we eagerly await the receipt of the articles.

In brief, The Incorporated Society of Planters and ISP Management (M) Sdn. Bhd. (ISPM) have accomplished their target to a larger extent, especially on IPC 2023, new memberships and renewals, producing *The Planter* magazine timely, and offering all year-round short courses and training. However, more efforts will be channelled to increase the membership collection which is still not encouraging.

In 2024, we plan to chart new strategies and goals to achieve our plans. We will be focussing on increasing revenue, optimising costs, increasing membership collections and identifying new sources of revenue through collaborations and consultancy. Finally, we wish members a 'Happy New Year and Merry Christmas!!'. We thank you for your continuous support!!


