Chief Executive's Notes

The first half of 2024 was promising and exciting with strong growth in membership, improved financial indicators and many activities at Branch level. All Branches had their AGM as per schedule and Kelantan Branch saw a change in leadership with Kameshwara Rao Sukumaran was elected as a Chairman.

At ISPHQ, one of the milestones achieved was the running of 2 Certificate in Plantation Management in Sibu and Bintulu. It was a collaboration between ISP Management (M) Sdn. Bhd. (ISPM), Methodist Pilley Institute and Sarawak Oil Palm Plantation Owners Association (SOPPOA). Fadzil Hitam and Chief Executive, Mr. Rajindran were present at this auspicious launching event. The official launch of ISP African Chapter was by Senator Abubakar Kyari, the Honorable Minister of Agriculture and Food Security, Nigeria. He is optimistic that ISP would help to bring world-class plantation management experience and expertise to proper the Region's Agriculture industry to greater heights. ISP is confident that with the establishment of this Chapter, many of the planters in African countries will join ISP.

The other anticipated event is National Seminar 2024 (NATSEM 2024). The Board of Directors (BOD), NATSEM 2024 Task Force and Secretariat are actively preparing for the success of NATSEM 2024 on 15 – 17 July 2024 in Miri, Sarawak.

Overall, the first half of 2024 has proven to be very fruitful and satisfactory. However, we will endeavour to do more in the coming months to achieve our goals.








ISP RAYA AIDILFITRI CELEBRATION

The event commenced with a welcome address by Dr Shermal Perera, the Protem Chairman of ISP Africa. He welcomed the guests and set the tone for the event, emphasising the significance of ISP's launch in Africa and the potential for sustainable and innovative agriculture practices in the Region.

Thereafter, Mr Mohammad Fadzil Hitam, Vice Chairman of ISP HQ, Malaysia, provided an overview of ISP and shared its history, objectives and achievements in promoting sustainable agriculture practices as well as contribution to the Plantation Industry as a whole.





Dr Tristan Durand, Scientific & Executive Director of PalmElit SAS, France, then took to the stage for a feature presentation which looked at the importance of food security and independence for Countries, and stressed that the African Region must recover its ranks in this regard.

The event then culminated with the official launch of ISP Africa by the Guest of Honour, Senator Abubakar Kyari, the Honourable Minister of Agriculture and Food Security, Nigeria, who expressed his hope that ISP would help bring world-class plantation management experience and expertise to propel the Region's Agriculture Industry to greater heights. He mentioned that "Agriculture remains the backbone of our economy, providing livelihood for millions of farmers and contributing significantly to our nation's food security, economic growth and social development. The theme of today's launch 'sustainable plantation agriculture for Africa's future' resonates with our national priority and aspirations".







This was followed by the Keynote Speech by Dr Akinwunmi Adesina, President, African Development Bank (AfDB), represented by Richard-Mark Mbaram, D.G Feed Nigeria Summit Secretariat. The keynote speech touched on the fact that by supporting initiatives such as ISP Africa, the AfDB aims to leverage agricultural development as a catalyst for broader economic transformation across the continent.

The event also saw goodwill speeches and messages from Ambassador Akinremi Bolaji, Director, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and HE Aiyub Bin Omar, High Commissioner Designate of Malaysia to Nigeria, duly represented by Ms Sharmini Devi Gopal, Counsellor, High Commission of Malaysia in Nigeria. Both speeches underscored the significance of ISP's launch in Africa and the potential it presented for G2G collaboration and growth in the Agriculture sector.





The guests were then feted to a sumptuous lunch of both local and international cuisine, where they were able to network amongst themselves and exchange ideas and experiences.





The final part of the launch comprised of the introduction of the pioneer members for the ISP Africa Chapter and 2 special Plenary Sessions. The 20 start-up members have already been submitted to ISP HQ for the official set-up of the Chapter.



• Plenary Session 1: Agriculture as a pathway to poverty alleviation - Developing commercial agriculture farming and empowering smallholder farmers in Africa

This session focused on the critical role of Agriculture in poverty alleviation and economic growth in Africa. The invited panellists discussed strategies for developing commercial agriculture farming and empowering smallholder farmers, including access to finance and markets; capacity building and training; technology adoption and innovation and partnerships and collaborations.



• Plenary Session 2: Leading sustainable corporations through ESG principles and the importance of ensuring sustainability parameters are adopted by plantation operations in Africa

This session emphasised the importance of Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) principles in promoting sustainable practices in agriculture and plantation operations. The invited panelists discussed the role of ESG in driving sustainability and responsible business practices, the importance of adopting sustainability parameters in plantation operations, strategies for implementing ESG principles in agriculture and plantation operations the benefits of ESG adoption, including improved reputation, risk management and access to finance.

ISP-EDUCATION FUND (ISP-EF)

On behalf of the Board of Directors and the ISP-Education Fund Committee (ISP-EFC), we have great pleasure to inform that The Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP) is offering **SCHOLARSHIP** to the children of ISP members-in-benefit, and staff's children who have been offered a tertiary education (bachelor degree or a degree programme) in any recognised Malaysian institutions of higher learning. They must have been enrolled in the following disciplines: Plantation and Agriculture including Husbandry, Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG), Sustainability, and related courses.

As part of the efforts to add value to members of The Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP), the ISP-Education Fund (ISP-EF) will provide financial assistance in funding tertiary education (bachelor degree or a degree programme) for Plantation and Agriculture including Husbandry, Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG), Sustainability, and related courses.

ISP, as a Non-Profit Organisation will fulfil its commitments by funding the tertiary education (bachelor degree or a degree programme) of the students. It shall be governed by a set of criteria and conditions on the selection and award of funding for 3 or 4 years, whichever is relevant. The ISP-EF Committee shall identify and select qualified candidates for the award. Recipients of ISP-EF are not bonded to the Society.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ISP-EF SCHOLARSHIP:
