### Chief Executive's Notes

#### Magic of ISP

The third quarter of 2024 was very exciting with many programs and activities held at HQ and Branch levels. We are almost back to the pre-pandemic era. The good news for this year is that a total of 935 new members have joined ISP. More interestingly, 127 have rejoined ISP. Therefore, I urge Branches to come up with a strategic plan to register new members and reach out to struck-off members to rejoin ISP. HQ is also doubling its efforts to register new members through meetings with company heads.

At the HQ level, we have established the African Chapter in Nigeria with 26 members, and we are now engaging with some Philippines plantation companies to form a second Chapter. Currently, we have 459 overseas members, and we plan to increase the numbers in the near future.

While we are trying to increase membership, we also face the problem of defaulters which has affected the revenue of ISP. Out of 5,022, members, only 70% to date have paid their annual subscription for 2024. We hope the defaulters will settle their dues as soon as possible. Another issue we face is that some members have diligently paid their subscription but have not sent their payment slip to HQ. Therefore, the status of these payees remains as defaulters until it has been reconciled.

The highlight of the third quarter was the overwhelming response to NATSEM 2024 held on 15 to 17 July in Miri, Sarawak. It must be said that it has exceeded our expectations with 850 participants. We would like to thank the members for your undivided support. We would like to apologise to our members and non-members for declining last-minute registrations, due to the overwhelming response to NATSEM 2024. NATSEM 2025 will be held on 12 - 14 July 2025 in Johore, and we encourage members to register soon to avoid disappointment. The Pre-Announcement will be out in October 2024. Another area we are focusing on now is the Advisory and Consultancy Unit. We have established it with highly experienced and skillful resource parsons. We have reached out to some plantation companies for consultancy work, and if this

and skillful resource persons. We have reached out to some plantation companies for consultancy work, and if this materialise, we can strengthen our revenue base for ISPM.






