A Remarkable Year For ISP/ISPM

Many plantation companies are expected to register better financial results by end of 2024 due to rising demand for palm oil from importing countries, handsome palm oil prices and lower cost of inputs.

Since ISP/ISPM is part of the plantation ecosystem, we too will be registering good financial results in 2024 compared to 2023.

As for membership, out of 5,106 ordinary members, 76% have paid their subscription for year 2024. We are optimistic that the rest will settle their payment before 31 December 2024. We are delighted to note that new members totalling 997 have joined ISP this year and 149 as rejoined members.

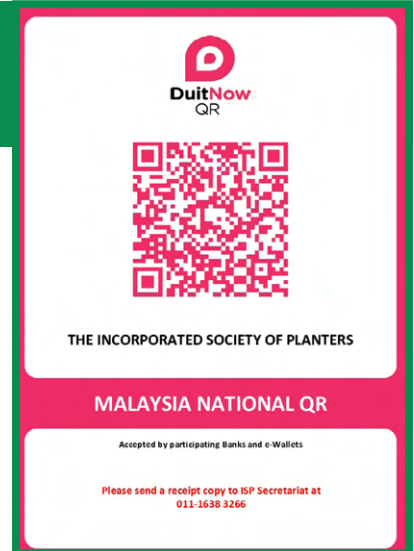
