12 April 2025

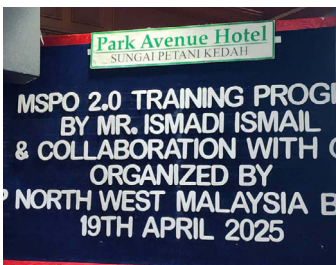

ISP South Terengganu/East Pahang Branch Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2025 19 April 2025

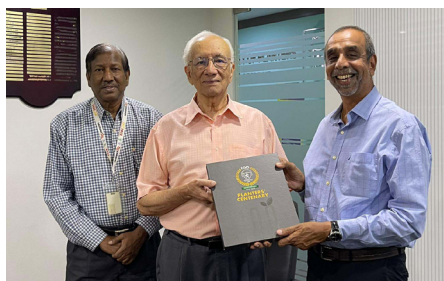

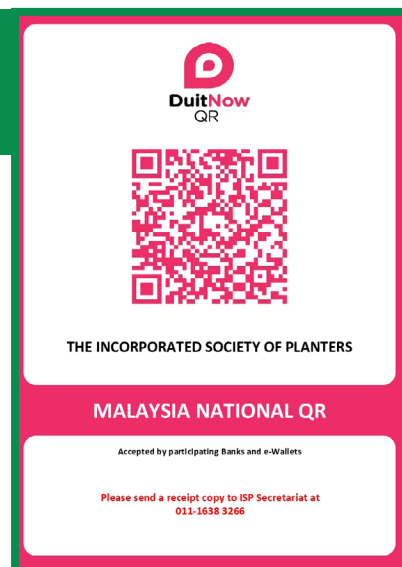

APPLICATION FOR ISP EXCELLENCE AWARD

1. The award is meant for SPM, STPM and A-Level or equivalent high achievers only.
2. It is open to ISP members' children including legally adopted children and children of ISP staff.
3. The members must be members-in-benefit (paid-up members) with a minimum of 3 years continuous membership and ISP staff, confirmed and with a minimum of 3 years' service with ISP, prior to the examination date.
