


### Meeting with RIAMTEC, SARAWAK 29 April 2025

The Incorporated Society of Planters (ISP), through its Education Fund Committee (ISP-EFC), is pleased to offer scholarships to children of ISP members-in-benefit and staff pursuing a bachelor's degree at any recognised Malaysian institution.

The scholarship supports studies in Plantation and Agriculture (including Husbandry), Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG), Sustainability, and related fields.

#### APPLICATION FOR ISP EXCELLENCE AWARD

- 1. The award is meant for SPM, STPM and A-Level or equivalent high achievers only.
- 2. It is open to ISP members' children including legally adopted children and children of ISP staff.
- 3. The members must be members-in-benefit (paid-up members) with a minimum of 3 years continuous membership and ISP staff, confirmed and with a minimum of 3 years' service with ISP, prior to the examination date.
- 4. ISP will allocate cash value for each category at the discretion of ISP Board of Directors.


